


Growing Together

Anglican and Catholic bishops to meet in Rome and Canterbury for the ecumenical summit "Growing Together" – during Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (January 22-29, 2024)

Pope Francis and the Archbishop of Canterbury will commission bishops for joint mission and witness on 25th January 2024.

Meeting during the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, bishops from the Anglican and Roman Catholic traditions will be gathering for Growing Together – a week-long summit for ecumenical discussion and pilgrimage in Rome and Canterbury between 22nd and 29th January 2024.



On January 25th, near the tomb of the Apostle Paul, Pope Francis and the Archbishop of Canterbury will commission the bishops, sending them out in pairs, to be witnesses to Christian Unity. This will be a significant moment, symbolic for Anglican-Catholic bonds and advancing ecumenical dialogue. The Summit is organised by IARCCUM – the International Anglican-Roman Catholic Commission for Unity and Mission. IARCCUM is an official commission of the Anglican Communion and the Catholic Church, established to promote ecumenical dialogue between the traditions.

Alongside daily discussions, the bishops will make visits to the following sites:

23rd January 2024

St Peter's Basilica for a tour and a service of Anglican Choral Evensong.

25th January 2024

Bishops visit the church of San Bartolomeo all'Isola, where the Archbishop of Canterbury will preside and preach at a sung Anglican Eucharist.

Commissioning of the bishops by the Archbishop of Canterbury and Pope Francis at the tomb of the Apostle Paul (Basilica of St Paul Outside The Walls)

26th January 2024

A visit to the church of San Gregorio al Celio, from where the first Archbishop of Canterbury was sent to England by Pope Gregory the Great in 597.

28th January 2024

Bishops to take part in Choral Eucharist at Canterbury Cathedral, where the Catholic Bishop of Hong Kong, Cardinal Stephen Chow, will preach. Discussions on a joint statement about the future work of IARCCUM / ongoing dialogue.

Some Good Tips for Readers & Extraordinary Ministers of HC

Readers:

- 1. Please continue to speak clearly whilst projecting your voice directly into the microphone. If you whisper in, then a whisper comes out. If you need to, adjust the microphone before Mass to make sure it is in the correct position.
- 2. For the Universal Prayers of Intercession (Bidding Prayers) please make your way to the ambo during the final few lines of the Creed. The reader should be at the ambo and ready before the priest begins the Opening Prayer.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:

1. For Communion, can the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion make their way to the sanctuary as soon as the "Lamb of God" begins. Extraordinary Ministers should be in place on the sanctuary for this prayer finishing and facing the altar for the priest saying: "Behold the Lamb of God".

Project Wellspring is now going to be piloted through several parishes in the Diocese, one in each Deanery. We are delighted to announce that St Mary's is the chosen parish for the Wishaw Deanery. Very soon Fr John-Paul will gather a same group of parishioners, perhaps 4 or 5, to look at a parish renewal scheme. This stage will also take into account the questionnaire forms completed several months ago.

This will also be a great opportunity to make sure that parishioners from Forth and Biggar feel included and valued within the parish, and what will work well for them.
